## Conference Bursary

**'Towards a New History of the Interwar Period', UNSW Canberra, 3-4 September 2019**

The Society for Military History and UNSW Canberra are pleased to offer a bursary to support PhD and Early Career scholars to attend the conference 'Towards a New History of the Interwar Period' in Canberra.

The bursary of \$1000AUD is intended to allow scholars who might not otherwise be able to travel to Canberra to engage with the region's foremost historians of war and the interwar period. The bursary reflects the commitment of the conference, UNSW Canberra and the Society of Military History to support the discussion of military history by historians with a wide range of approaches, topics and backgrounds. Scholars who take innovative and interdisciplinary approaches to military history, or who are currently studying areas not considered 'traditional' military history are particularly encouraged to apply.

The bursary will go towards the cost of airfares and accommodation. Conference attendance will be free. During the conference, the bursary winner will meet and network with the conference organisers and representatives of the Society for Military History. The scholar will have their attendance reported in the Society of Military History's newsletter and on social media.

### **Eligibility**

Applicants should be currently undertaking a PhD or within three years of the conferral of their PhD (or equivalent if they have experienced academic interruptions), and should be studying a military history topic, broadly defined.
