

CALL FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST FOR NEW EDITOR/S

History Australia (2022-2024)

History Australia is the official journal of the Australian Historical Association. The journal aims to reflect the diversity of history in Australia by publishing the research and increasing the professional self-awareness of historians making, teaching and applying history. It publishes peer-reviewed articles that draw on new historical research or address ways of teaching, exhibiting or applying historical knowledge. It is currently published by Taylor & Francis, with four issues appearing each year, in print and online.

The current editors of *History Australia*, Michelle Arrow, Leigh Boucher and Kate Fullagar complete their term on 31 December 2021. The Executive welcomes expressions of interest from candidates located in any Australian university or universities, and engaged in any variety of history, to be received by **Friday 4 December 2020**.

Expressions of interest should include:

- A brief outline of ideas on the future direction of the journal
- Evidence of the level of support in terms of administrative assistance and, where relevant, teaching relief to be provided by the new editor or editorial team's home institution(s). Applicants should note that the current editorial team is supported by editorial assistance for six hours per week.
- A brief CV (one page max) for each member of the proposed team, including previous editorial or organisational experience and research strengths.
